### **Roles & responsibilities:**

- All partners should identify one or more potential Learning Facilitators , please the section highlighting How to become a JOC Learning Facilitator in the “Introduction to competition” Context
- To issue a letter recommending the candidate , along with the following attachments furnished by the candidate course facilitator
  - A letter explaining his rationale for wishing to become a course facilitator in the Jordan Coaching Certification Program. Why?
  - His curriculum vitae emphasizing his educational and sport background.
  - Highlight his experience as a course conductor or experience in adult teaching.
  - A copy of his bachelor degree.
  - A copy of his coaching certification from the Sport Federation.
  - A letter from the Club President certifying of his active role as a coach, the number of years of coaching experience, and his moral and professional integrity.
  - A letter from an opposing coach attesting to his moral and professional integrity.

Following the delivery of the initial courses in March 2009, sport federations and the paralympic committee that are part of the NCCP should develop plans for the delivery of the program within their sport (or in sport groupings with other sports). Learning Facilitator candidates who successfully complete the training should be expected to teach at least part of 2-4 courses per year.
